REQUEST FOR CONSULTANT STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

For

***GENERAL PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR WATER FACILITY INSTRUMENTATION
AND CONTROL SYSTEMS AND LOW/MEDIUM DUTY ELECTRICAL***

The Peace River Manasota Regional Water Supply Authority (Authority) is requesting 'Statement of Qualifications' (SOQ) from consultants (Consultant) for the purpose of providing general services for instrumentation and control and low/medium duty industrial electrical systems associated with the Authority's drinking water treatment, storage and transmission facilities.

Professional services will support Authority's water treatment, storage and transmission system and may include, but not be limited to, PLC programming, diagnostics, maintenance, and updates/upgrade of GE FANUC/iFIX SCADA system and other electronic data collection and control systems, data storage and database management, design of instrumentation and control systems, and troubleshooting and repair of other water facility electronic and industrial electrical systems up to 23.5 kV. Consultants are free to consider teaming as needed to achieve the scope of qualifications requested. Work will be assigned on a project specific basis.

Firms providing these professional services must demonstrate compliance with the rules and regulations of the Authority and other agencies as may be applicable for specific projects.

Consultant selection will be in accordance with the Authority's Procurement Policy (available at www.regionalwater.org) and the Competitive Consultants Negotiation Act. Firms desiring to provide these professional services to the Authority must submit six (6) paper copies, and six (6) electronic PDF copies of their SOQ in accordance with the requirements contained in the information packet to the attention of Patrick Lehman, Executive Director, at the address listed in the information packet no later than 2:00 pm local time, March 9, 2012.
